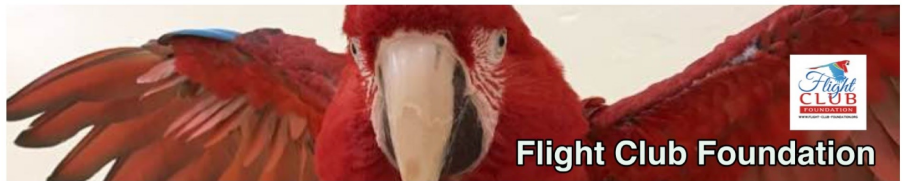

What a year it's been! Each year, Flight Club Foundation works hard to share knowledge about the world of parrots and everything connected to them. Each year, we celebrate all that we do in one, massive, epic performance of my life, Seattle Parrot Expo. A dream I had now over 20 years ago as I worked at Rainforest Cafe. An idea that grows and evolves into the refined beauty of reality.

This year is especially special for me. It's the first year ever combining all of the separate forces I have created into one, single, far more manageable entity. The years of accounting nightmares continue, but at least it's all on one ledger. Now, for the first time since I left Rainforest Cafe in 2005, I am a full-time employee once more. Sorely needed in this day and age with a looming retirement and lack of funds for social security from being a stay-at-home mom to my special needs son who has grown to a young man.

Our wings embrace so many, with testaments coming from audiences we reach stating things like, "Thank you for the best day of my life," to hearing, "I'm not alone anymore."

My passion and drive is now 100% on Flight Club Foundation in hopes of a future, permanent location; a salary worth working for by someone else; possibly hiring a team. Imagine being able to fully utilize our parrot humane license and have a humane society of our own just for exotics.

Imagine having a resource refuge for exotic animals that consists of a network of breeders, rescuers, store owners, manufacturers, veterinarians, parrot owners, zoos, conservationists, sanctuaries all in league to help parrots. What I like to call, "the complete wheel without which there is no forward motion".

Most of us do this work voluntarily. It takes a massive volunteer base to even consider the steps we have taken so far. A volunteer base that receives calls in the middle of the night for bird crises, that climbs trees to recover birds for strangers, that consoles a partner who loses his wife to cancer, that brings on a behavioral challenge in hopes of success.

We remember little Eddy, the cutest, most terrified Cherry head conure I have seen at less than a year old. The owner was going to give up and possibly re-home him. Now, they are the best buddies ever. The story of a found cockatiel by Bonnie Vallet we stepped in and paid for detailed veterinary examination as the bird was injured while it was loose.

Peppy the Patagonian Parrot, my own, new member of the flock, discovering lead poisoning with baseline x-rays. I cannot recommend them enough as we are now holding an adorable lilac crown amazon we discovered heart disease in. Your donations help us help them.

We do not ask for donations to adopt parrots out. We just ask for stability, a membership, a follow up, loyalty. It's your contributions at Seattle Parrot Expo and annual fundraising that allows us to do all that we do for so many projects, events, and conservation donations we do.

This is my motto I state at the end of every show I perform, "Save a Parrot Today, Save YOURSELF Tomorrow!" As you visit our Expo, think of ways to GO GREEN—give back your lanyard to our office, return our program, refill your water bottle at the refill station, recycle the cans or bottles in recycling, keep garbage out of recycling. Together, we have a brighter future.

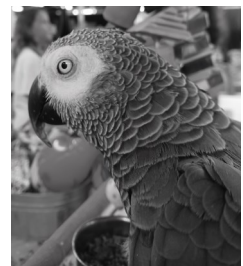

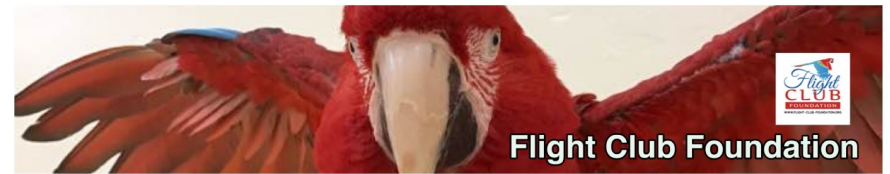

Flight Club Foundation works hard annually to produce many programs that help Parrots and People too. Flight Club Foundation specializes as a parrot adoption, recovery, rehab, owner-centered training and triage organization (or PARROTT program). Grants, membership, store purchase, online auctions and more provide our ability to give back to other deserving nonprofits. If we succeed in raising funds above costs at Seattle Parrot Expo every year, we issue what we call a Parrot Grant annually. To date, we have given \$10,000 of our own funds vs. donor funds to over a dozen nonprofits globally.



The Macaw Society

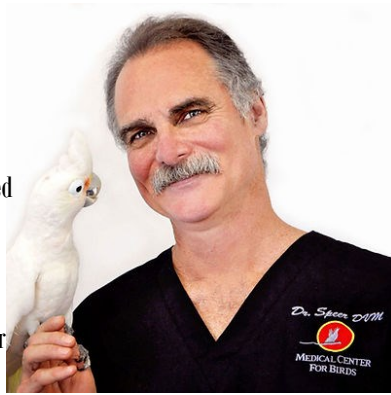
The mission of The Macaw Society is to efficiently use information to direct conservation of the studied species in Peru—and in other locations where psittacines are declining and are at risk of extinction. Moving forward, it will operate with a more global perspective throughout the neotropics and work to establish new research alliances.

While The Macaw Society's research base remains in the Tambopata region, it's in a new location and no longer associated with eco-tourism companies. Collaborations will continue with the focus shifting to more advising of direct conservation and local action plans.

Dr. Brian Speer, DVM

Dr. Brian Speer received his DVM from the University of California at Davis, in 1983. Board specialty status was awarded through the American Board of Veterinary Practitioners in 1996, and in 1999, he was certified in the European College of Avian Medicine and Surgery (ECAMS, now ECZM). Currently in private practice and director of the Medical Center for Birds in Northern California. Brian has also served the Association of Avian Veterinarians (AAV), as chair of the Aviculture Committee, as director of the board, and as president. He has served the ECZM as scientific committee chair and as a member of the examination committee. Dr. Speer is a consultant for the Veterinary Information Network, for avian medical topics. He co-authored *The Large Macaws* (1995), *Birds for Dummies* (1999 & second edition 2021). Brian edited the *Current Veterinary Therapy in Avian Medicine and Surgery* (2015), as well as being co-editor of the highly anticipated 2023, Volume Two.

Hildegard Niemann

Hildegard graduated as a biologist in 1993 from the Westfälische Wilhelms-Universität in Münster. She has worked as a behavior consultant for parrots and parakeets (Parrot Behaviour Consulting [PBC]) since 2004. She's been a

Certified member of International Association of Animal Behavior Consultants (IAABC), a member of the American Federation of Aviculture (AFA) and the International Association of Avian Trainers and Educators (IAATE) since 2006. Since 1996, Hildegard has authored over 140 published papers on parrots and other ornamental birds and a total of 8 books. She hosts regular organized workshops for parrot keepers, leads practical training sessions (PPT) and offers online courses and webinars. She has led trips to the Philippines, New Zealand, Australia, Costa Rica and Ecuador. She has taught at AFA, SPE, NPRPF, EXOTIS (Switzerland), Aviculture Society of Australia; continuing education events like Parrot Days (Stuttgart), Pet Day (German Veterinary Society) and lecturing at Academy for Innovative Education and Management, the Institute in Schongau and at the Central Association of Zoological Enterprises. She has given technical lectures at the conference of the Fund for Endangered Parrots and was a member of the Wellensittich-und-Papageien-Magazin for 13-years.

Hildegard had kept parrots for over 30-years. Including Budgies, Cockatiels, Amazons, Catherine Parakeets, Black-headed parrots and Grey parrots.

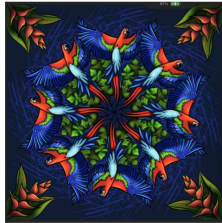

Dr. Donald J. Brightsmith & Dr. Gabriela Vigo-Trauco

The Macaw Society (previously known as the Tambopata Macaw Project) is a long-term research study of the ecology and conservation of macaws and parrots that started in 1999. Lead by Dr. Donald J. Brightsmith and Dr. Gabriela Vigo-Trauco, both of the Schubot Center for Avian Health, at the Texas A&M School of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences (VMBX). Which switched it's focus in 2006. Dr. Brightsmith's team was not the first on to work with macaws in the

area. However, they were the first to collect scientific information that produced clear documentation of the natural history and ecology of the parrots and macaws in Tambopata—and make it available to the public. His team now ranks as one of the best in the world when it comes to macaw research and conservation. After documenting and publishing important baseline data, the mission of the The Macaw Society is to efficiently use the information to direct conservation of the studied species in Peru, as well as other locations where psittacines are declining and are at risk of extinction. In the future, it will operate with more global perspective. While The Macaw Society's new location is still in the Tambopata region, it is no longer associated with eco-tourism companies. Collaborations will continue, but the focus will shift to advising direct conservation and local action plans.



Laurella Desborough

Laurella Desborough obtained a Master's Degree in General Biology and Zoology from Southern Illinois University and UCLA in 1965! She has been a professional aviculturist or breeder of exotic birds for over 20-years. This includes amazons, greys, cockatoos, brown-headed parrots, hawkheads and mini-macaws. She currently specialized in Eclectus and Vasa Parrots. Laurella is the current Legislative Coordinator for the National Animal Interest Alliance Trust; www.naiatrust.org. And past President of the American Federation of Aviculture, AFA;



She is the co-founder of the Model Aviculture Program recently utilized during dialogue for USDA regulation. She continues to serve on the board, where she certifies avicultural practices utilizing voluntary inspection for the best practice procedures; a program now adapted in several other countries.

Laurella's current memberships are: American Bird Conservancy, American Federation of Aviculture, American Pheasant and Waterfowl Society, Avicultural Society of America, Florida Federation of Aviculture, National Animal Interest Alliance, National Audubon Society, National Avian Welfare Alliance and Organization of Professional Aviculturists.

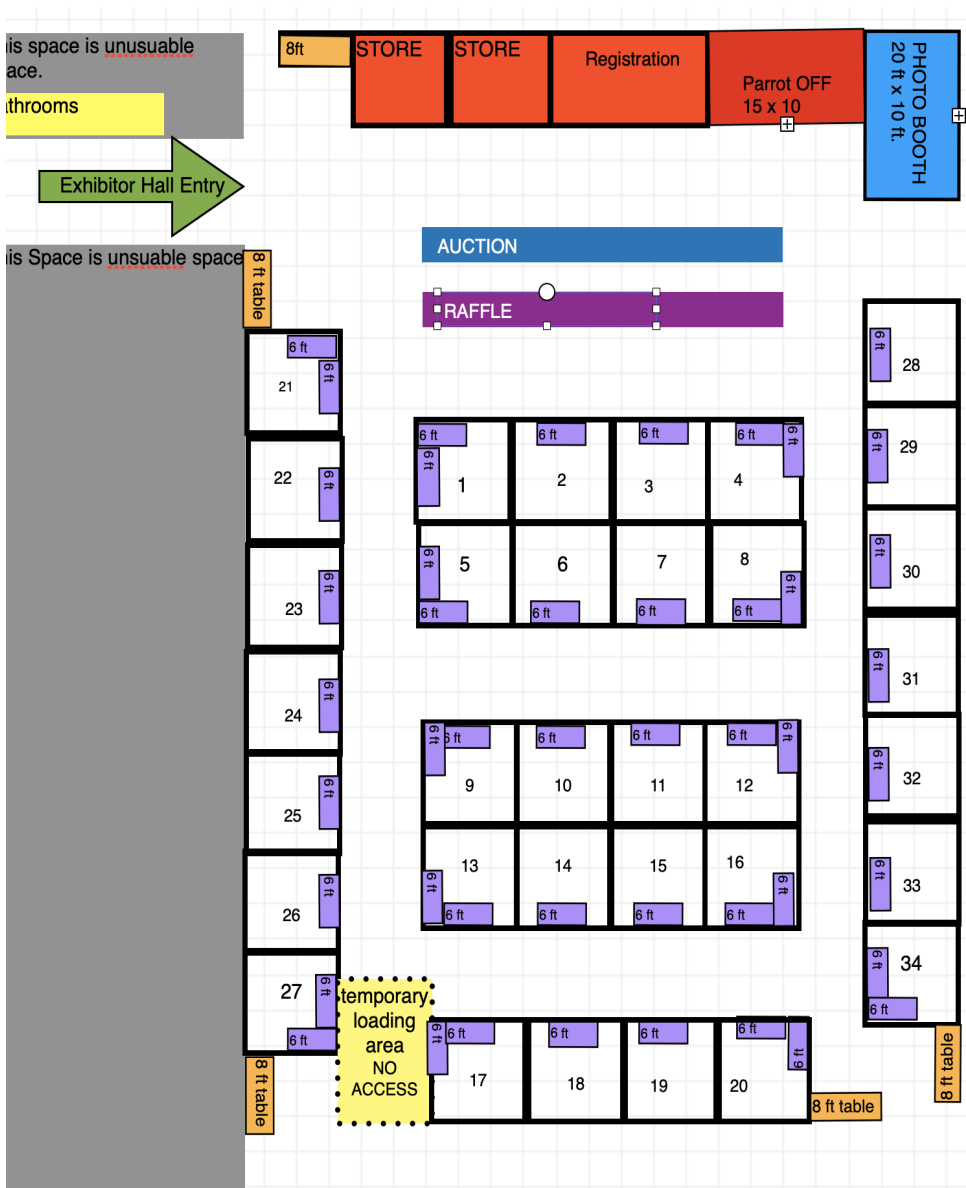
